Who Is Insured Under The Policy?

The policy has the ability to cover both the rowing club and any nominated individuals that store their rowing sculls at the club location.

What About Public Liability Cover?

Cover for Public Liability cover is not required as part of this policy. The reason for this is that all Rowing Australia affiliated clubs and rowing Australia members are covered for Marine Hull Liability via the Australian Rowing National Public Liability Policy. For non motorised hulls there is no limit on the length of the rowing hull/scull, solo training cover is also included. For motorised hulls the hull must be under 21 metres in length to be covered by the Australian Rowing National Public Liability Policy. The limit of liability is \$20,000,000. The liability excess is \$1,000 each plus every claim.

What are the Policy Excesses?

SUM INSURED	POLICY EXCESS
\$0-\$15,000	\$250 per insured item
\$15,001 - \$25,000	\$350 per insured item
\$25,001 - \$50,000	\$500 per insured item
\$50,000 and above	\$1,000 per insured item

Oars	\$50
Motorised Hulls	\$100
